 - leave no trash, any waste has to be deposited in the waste bins at the start/finish location
 - follow the signs of the trails and stay on the paths
 - do not disturb plants or animals, be respectful for other visitors

- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of cancellation by the participant and will go to the Chimp Eden sanctuary.
